AUGUST ULTREYA

“Be merciful to others as God is to you” served as the theme for the August Ultreya. Led by the grouping sisters of Patti Willems, Shaina Silliker, Joanne Cavallari, and Liz Lilly; Joanne served as the moderator for the evening. Liz opened the evening with a prayer about mercy. Patti shared the scripture for the evening, Matthew 18:21-19:1.

After grouping, Shaina gave the witness talk. Shaina shared that Cursillo was an amazing experience for her, but not life changing. She was doing piety, study and action, just didn't know it. The ministry that has been most revealing of her 4th day is the youth ministry. This summer she had the opportunity to lead a girls' group. She led the girls in opening prayer, studying a book entitled “Loved As I Am.” The book was relatable to the teens and the discussion questions guided the topics each week. After the group ends they sit and discuss various things. Shaina said that she is blessed to witness the spiritual growth of the girls.

Deacon Michael Pettit reflected on the Gospel and theme of the evening. God has already forgiven us our trespasses so we must forgive those who trespass against us. We all have someone that we harbor animosity toward. Pray for that person... that God will reveal himself to that person. Continuing to do that will allow us to let go of the animosity. Jesus tells us to love one another as I have loved you. Take the time to sit and visualize your earliest memories through recent moments. If you see a moment where there is hurt, let it go. Pray for the person who wronged you. We have to be full of love.
